- All members of Golf Courses who will help us in the Summer Months will receive the Family Rate. Their Pro or an employee of the Golf Shop must call to receive this rate.

## The Tennis Corner

December is now here, and for many of us December is a busy as well as stressful month. How about playing some tennis as a form of relaxation or just away to take frustration out on a tennis ball? As we head into winter the weather is always a major consideration in deciding whether or not to play. Ideally for the Tuesday evening open play, the general rule of thumb is that the temperature must be 50 degrees or above. However, with the Sunday open play starting at 12:30, the temperatures are more than often not as much a reason not to play. If in doubt as to whether or not anyone is playing on these days, feel free to telephone Cathy Hadad at 288-5918.

One of the Taberna tennis etiquette rules is to sweep the court and clean the lines following play. You will find the necessary tools for these duties on the inner fences. To sweep court there is a brush with black bristles (do not use the steel brush). After sweeping the court, it is important to roll the lines to remove the har-tru which has accumulated from the sweeping. You will find the rollers attached the to the fence which divides the courts. By cleaning the courts you are leaving the courts ready for play for the next individual or group.

As the end of the year approaches so does the WTA and ATP 2021 finals. The women's finals were held in Guadalajara, Mexico. The championship match was between Garbine Muguruza of Spain and Anett Kontaveit of Estonia. The Spaniard won 6-3, 7-5. The doubles were Su-wei Hsieh of Chinese Taipei and Elise Mertens of Belgium against Barbora Krejcikova and Katerina Siniakova both of the Czech Republic with the Czech girls winning 6-3, 6-4.

The ATP finals were held in Turin, Italy. The championship match was between Alexander Zverev (of Germany) and Daniil Medvedev (of Russia). Zverev won the match 6-4, 6-4. En route to his victory Zverev and to beat #1 Novak Djokovic in the semifinals. The doubles finals did have one American in the finals, Rajeey Ram teamed up with British player Joe Salisbury. Unfortunately, they lost to Frenchmen Pierre-Hugues Herbert and Nicolas Mahut 6-4, 7-6.

In the above mentioned end of the year finals in which only one American was in a final match of both the women and men championship matches, it is interesting that Chris Evert wrote an interesting piece in Tennis Magazine. While written prior to the finals, she wrote about the fact that there is a lack of men's Grand Slam singles champion since 2003, and only two not named Williams on the women's side over this same time. While the US continues to produce excellent players, the fact is that the rest of the world has caught up with us. Even in smaller countries with fewer resources, tennis is far more popular than in the U.S. It seems that here in the U.S. there has been a talent drain due to the opportunities and riches to play team sports at the professional level, especially for men. Sounds like a good reason to me.

I want to take this opportunity to wish all of you Taberna members a Merry Christmas/Happy Hanukkah and best wishes for the New Year.
