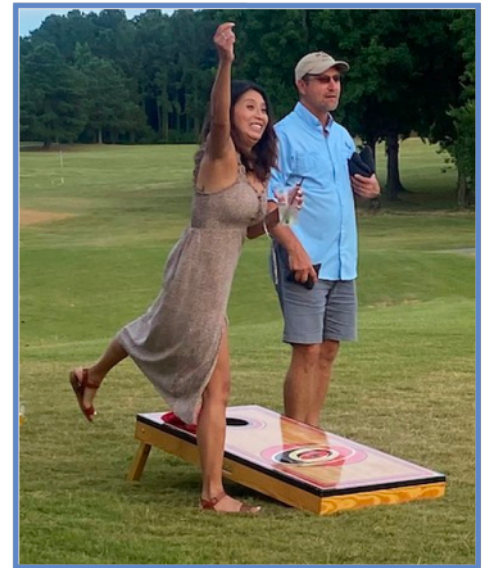

and-a-half days!

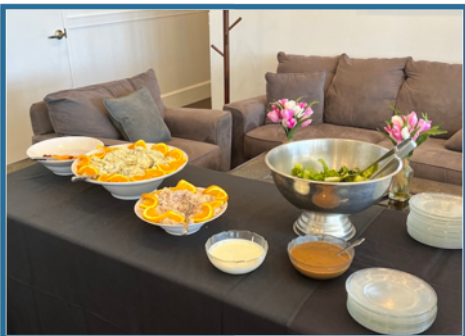

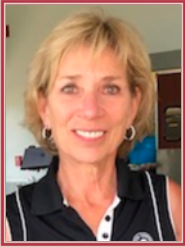
## JUNE EVENTS AT TCC

February – American Film actor

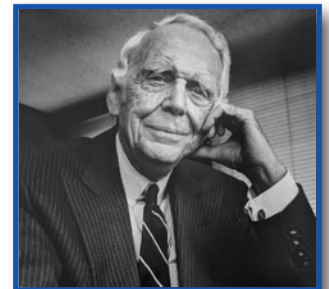

# THE TENNIS CORNER

We tennis players got our wish — warm weather is here — or is it too warm? I have been a member of TCC for a good 19 years.
