



THE TENNIS CORNER

WITH BARBARA FLYNN



While the golfers are awaiting the reopening of the golf course (which may be open by the time you read this), the tennis courts are open for all. We regulars have noticed from time to time other club members using the courts, which is very encouraging. It appears as though the summer heat is cooling off a bit which is always good news.

Regarding your tennis racquet, there are three major considerations when purchasing a new racquet or just adjusting your current racquet. The correct racquet head size and string tensions and even small adjustments can make a big difference not only in performance but also in preventing injury.

The overgrip is important to change on a regular basis because that helps to prevent blisters and flipping of the racquet. The string tension and string size can contribute to elbow, shoulder and wrist problems.

Lastly, for anyone with shoulder, elbow, wrist, or even

lower extremity problems, there may be something that you may tweak in your technique that can make a big difference in your game and comfort on the tennis court.

August 29th marks the beginning of the U.S. Open Tennis Tournament In New York City and continuing through to the Men's Final which will be held on Sunday, September 11th.

The big news is that Serena Williams has announced her plan to retire following the U.S. Open. Also, Angelique Kerber will be missing the tournament due to the fact that she is expecting her first child. On the men's side, Novak Djokovic will not be playing because of his Covid -19 vaccination status since he refuses to be vaccinated against Covid. Roger Federer will be missing his third U.S. Open in a row. Rafael Nadal and John Isner will both be participating in the tournament.
