To assist you in your efforts, listed below are a few facts concerning 10 of the monthly photos, some off which are actually true:


O Nobel prize winning Danish physicist (1888-1962) known primarily for his work in quantum theory. Fun fact: Is reported

Musings from Barb...

Rule 9: If your driver is hot, your putter is ice cold; if you can hit your irons, you will top your woods; if you keep your right elbow tucked in, your head will come up.


Rule 10: Never try to keep more than 300 separate thoughts in your mind during your swing.


Rule 11: Every par-three hole in the world has a secret desire to humiliate golfers. The shorter the hole, the greater that desire.
