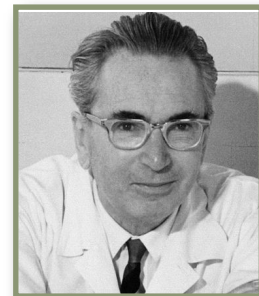

## Musings from Barb...

might apply to a driver too.

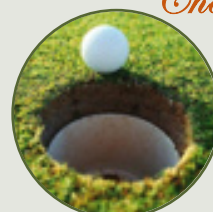

**Rule 12:** A good drive on the 18th hole has stopped many a golfer from giving up the game.

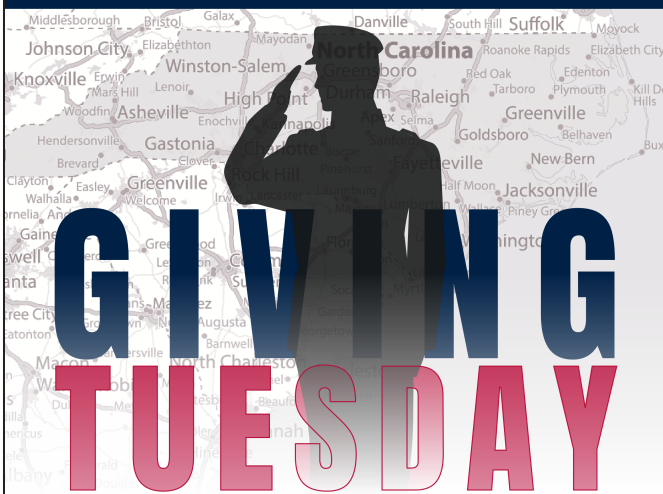

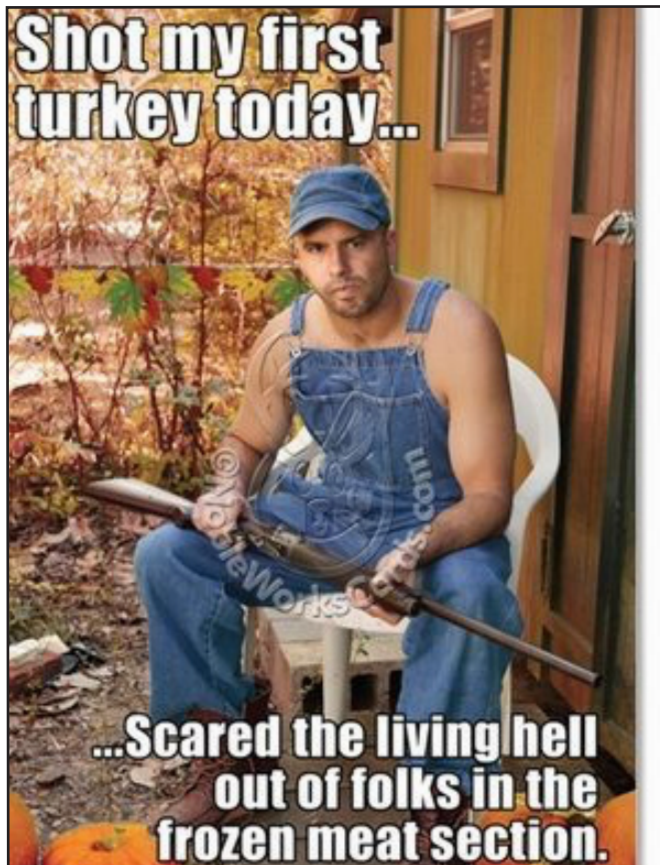
