Djokovic did pull out of Indian Wells on the eve of the draw; he also did not play in the Miami Open. This should allow Djokovic to play in the U.S. Open (August 28 - September 10).

Calling all TWGA Members! It's All Hands on Deck to support our club and the female professional golfers on the EPSON Tour. The Champions Fore Change

Invitational starts on Monday afternoon, May 29th (Memorial Day) and runs through Sunday afternoon, June 4th. If you haven't attended a professional golf tournament, this is your chance to participate and learn about all the different activities that take place at each tournament event. We're all familiar with the volunteers who hold the "Quiet Please" signs at LPGA and PGA Tournaments on television. We need some of those volunteers and much more!

Monday afternoon, May 29th, Tuesday, May 30th and Wednesday, May 31st are reserved for practice rounds for the golfers. Thursday, June 1st is the Pro-Am. Volunteers are needed for each of these days to help register players and other volunteers, provide general information, assist with special events, re-stock coolers on course, maintain trash receptacles and preserve the cleanliness of the course. Fifteen to thirty volunteers are needed Monday through Wednesday and twenty-five to forty are needed on Thursday for the Pro-Am.

An even larger number of volunteers (100 to 150) is needed Friday, June 2nd through Sunday, June 4th when the tournament will be played. In addition

to the tasks listed above, volunteers are needed to:

- work the driving range and as sist player caddies;
- work on the 1st and 10th tees as a starter to announce players, give out scorecards and last-minute information;
- act as Marshalls and spotters; carry the standard-bearer sign with players names and scores and update scores. This is a 2-person team needed only on Sunday. They walk the course with the players.
- Scoring data volunteers train ing is provided and many vol unteers are needed for the fol lowing:
- Cart Scorers follow a group of players and keep an unofficial score and stats for the group.
 Communicate with scoring tent via 2-way radio after each hole.
- Real-Time Scoring Computer

 Operator data entry and com
 puter knowledge needed
- Real-Time Scoring Radio Oper ator – communicates with cart scorers, records scores after each hole and gives data to the

Computer Operator.

- Scoreboard and Leaderboards continually update the main and on-course leaderboards with information provided by iPads.
- Scoring Tent verify scorecards after the player has completed the round

There's something on this list for you! Volunteers receive a lunch voucher for each day worked and one complimentary round of golf at Taberna if you work at least two shifts. If you're a member, you get a free guest pass. Volunteers wear official tournament golf shirts and hats that are ordered during the sign-up process. There is a charge of \$30 per volunteer to cover the cost of the shirts. To sign up, please use this link:
