## Hot & Spicy Homemade Chex Party Mix



#### **INGREDIENTS**

3 cups Corn Chex™ cereal

3 cups Rice Chex™ cereal

3 cups Wheat Chex™ cereal

1 cup mixed nuts

1 cup pretzels

1 cup bite-size cheese crackers

1/4 cup butter or margarine

1 tablespoon Worcestershire sauce

1 1/4 teaspoons seasoned salt

2 to 3 teaspoons red pepper sauce

#### **PREPARATION**

In large microwavable bowl, mix cereals, nuts, pretzels and crackers; set aside. In small microwavable bowl, microwave butter uncovered on High about 40 seconds or until melted. Stir in Worcestershire sauce, seasoned salt and red pepper sauce. Pour over cereal mixture; stir until evenly coated.

Microwave uncovered on High 5 to 6 minutes, thoroughly stirring every 2 minutes. Spread on paper towels to cool. Store in airtight container.

On July 12, Polish tennis star, Iga Swiatek, defeated American Amanda Anisimova 6-0, 6-0 to capture the Wimbledon women's singles championship. With this win, she has now captured championships

on all three surfaces.

In the men's Wimbledon championship, Jannik Sinner defeated Spain's Carlos Alcaraz 4-6, 6-4, 6-4, 6-4 to become the first Italian player to ever win Wimbledon.

At the US Open in New York, American Amanda Anisimova battled her way to the finals but fell to world number one Aryna Sabalenka of Belarus (3-6, 6-7).

On the men's side, Carlos Alcaraz and Jannik Sinner clashed again in a block-buster final. Alcaraz, just 22, became the youngest man in history to reach multiple Grand Slam finals on all three surfaces. He defeated Sinner 6-2, 3-6, 6-1, 6-4, and reclaimed the world number one ranking.
