We need to defend our title! We'll see who needs golf lessons after that!

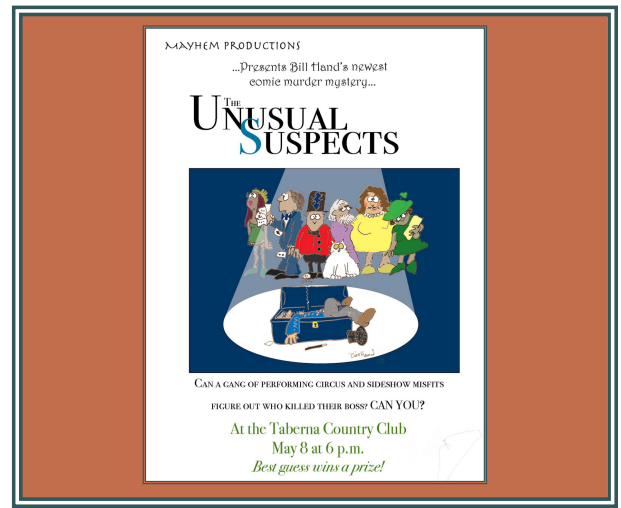
Also, we have two interclub golf events scheduled on Monday, April 20th and April 27th with Home and Home and CCGA.

THE TENNIS CORNER

WITH BARBARA FLYNN



At last we are experiencing good weather for playing tennis outdoors. After a cold, rainy winter, it is so good to have warm weather here in Eastern NC again. Hopefully, this warmer weather is here to stay.

The Neuse River Senior Games tennis competition will be Monday, May 4 at The Emerald Golf Club. By the time you read this, it will be too late to register to play in the games as the registration deadline is Monday, March 16. However, should you be interested in being a spectator, the tennis events are as follows:

- Singles/Doubles 9:00AM.
- Mixed Doubles 12:00PM.

On the professional side of tennis, during the week of January 20th, Novak Djokovic won his 100th Australian Open match. He is now just three wins away from passing Roger Federer's all-time mark of 102.

Djokovic then went on to the finals where he lost to Carlos Alcaraz in four sets. This win for Alcaraz gave him the distinction of being the youngest player to complete a Grand Slam. Djokovic had never

lost in his previous finals in the Australian Open. In the men's doubles, American Christian Harrison and his British partner Neal Skupski won the title. This was the first time they had played as partners.

Did you know that Tommy Paul is a Greenville native? Paul is a member of the 2026 American Davis Cup team. Davis Cup in its 14th edition is competition between national teams in men's tennis. There are 158 nations competing this year. After defeating Hungary 4-0, we lost to the Czech Republic 3-2 in Delray Beach, FL. This was one of the biggest shocks of a Davis Cup qualifier. The United States men are 32-time champions.

Coming up Grand Slams are the French Open and Wimbledon. The French Open is scheduled for May 24 – June 7. Wimbledon is scheduled for June 29 – July 12.
